

## Pastor Sunny's Rays

Can you believe that we are already in Lent for 2010? Time is moving way too fast for my poor old, feeble brain to keep up some days. Our District Superintendent sent out a quote from Leonardo De Vinci: "*Every now* and then go away, have a little relaxation, for when you come back to your work your judgment will be surer. 
