





Of your Savior Son the One who saves


The summer days we thank you for

PROPHESY #20: New Program for the Church

If you were a Jew in the Old Testament times, you would believe that: 1) you were a member of God's chosen people, 2) you needed to be obedient to God's laws, 3) you should honor and worship God, 4) you would be rewarded with heaven.

During New Testament times, the rules had not changed, but by now, the nation of Israel had a history of many military defeats and subjugation to rulers of other nations. Jewish traditions were carried on by the Faithful, but many Jews adopted the beliefs and practices of the heathen. The Faithful prayed for deliverance, and longed for the promised Messiah who would defeat their enemies and bring them into a kingdom of peace, under His rule.

This was the "old program". And God kept his promises (recorded in the Bible). The Messiah was born according to the predictions, and began revealing himself to the Jews. Jesus chose twelve disciples to help with his work. The disciples recognized Jesus as the Holy One who fulfilled scripture... and the number of followers grew.

Unfortunately, the powerful Jewish leaders: the elders, the High Priest, the teachers of the law and scripture, and most of the judicial body, did not believe. The rejection of Jesus by so many Jews called for a "new program".

The "new program" had Jesus reaching out to all who would listen. (Jew or Gentile). The "new program" did not cancel the "old program", but it added on to, and expanded it. In the past, Jews hated their enemies. Now Jesus spoke of love toward all. Jesus talked about his followers becoming servants of all, helping everyone. Many of the qualities that Jesus urged were recorded in the Beatitudes. (be this... be this...) (Matthew 5:1-10) And... being loving, helping, serving people has its reward. Jesus said that those people would be blessed. To be blessed is to be happy. This is a happiness that comes from pleasing our savior and God.

What if a Christian thinks that he or she does not have the personality to do the work of the "new program"? That is where the Holy Spirit comes in. If we ask the Holy Spirit to help us, He will fill us with power to do the things that we never thought we could do. (See the story of the apostles at Pentecost, found in the New Testament book of Acts.)

God filled the apostles with power in the past. He is filling Christians now with power to do His work.

PRESENT: Gary Enderle, Rob Cornell, Pastor Burt, Judy Krott, Bernie Hawks, Bob Rasmusson, and Marshall Allen.

6:00 p.m. Pastor Burt called the meeting to order and opened with prayer.

April 5, 2017, Minutes were read and discussed. Gary made a motion to approve the minutes. Rob seconded the motion, and all approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Rob presented this report and discussion followed. Marshall made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Bob seconded the motion, and all approved.

Discussion of Trustee Topics:

- *Metal Door on Wesley Hall was installed.
- *A new motor in the garbage disposal will be installed on May 4, 2017.
- *The brick work on the front of the church is complete, and the brick wall outside Wesley Hall was repaired.
- *Another cleaning day was scheduled for June 3. The sanctuary and other areas on this floor need cleaning. All windows have been cleaned.
- *Two fire extinguishers in the sanctuary are missing. Rob Cornell will contact Larry Self to get fire extinguishers replaced as soon as possible.
- *The railings on the main entrance to the church are very rusted. It was suggested that we install new vinyl railings. Bernie will research the cost of having this done.
- *A railing needs to be installed on the outside of the exit door in Wesley Hall.
- *The Green Street fover needs to be painted.
- *A small vacuum is needed to clean the pews. We will check to see if our new vacuum will work for this task.
- *Toilet seats need to be changed.
- *Baseboard heater covers are rusted and need to be replaced. Marshall volunteered to replace these when we are ready to complete this task.
- *Our new television is mounted on the wall in Wesley Hall. Marshall will install a shelf for the DVD player and the speakers.
- *Laura Smith's group of Girl Scouts will continue to use Wesley Hall on Tuesday evenings.
- *First Aid Kits were purchased.
- *Incident reports must be completed for all incidents that occur on church property.
- *A discussion of informing the congregation of Trustee business occurred. It was suggested that Bernie announce in Church our concerns and updates and that our approved minutes could be listed in the newsletter.

Dudley likes routine... and knowing what's going to happen, when. So when I recently got up at 4:00 AM and left the house by 5:00 AM, he (and Tucker) were confused and a bit anxious. They had no way of knowing that I was embarking on a six hour drive to Annapolis, MD and would not return until eighteen hours later.

I don't like leaving my canine family members for long periods of time, and I don't make a habit of it. But our daughter had asked for assistance in driving our grandson to the Naval Academy, and I relished the opportunity of spending time with them. I gave Dudley and Tucker everything they needed



to survive the time without me. They had food, water, treats, and my husband to let them out. And, although they did not know when I would return, they had my words saying, "Don't worry. I'll be coming back. I love you."

I am told that while I am away from them, Dudley and Tucker often isolate themselves and don't respond to other people. They miss their master. They believe I am coming back... but the longer they wait, the more they wonder how long it will be.

When Christ walked the earth with his disciples, he often spoke with them about future events. He told them that the Jewish temple would be destroyed. (Matthew 24:1-2) It was in 70 AD. He told them that the Holy Spirit would come upon them after his ascension. (Acts 1:5,8) It did at Pentecost. He told then that he would come again to earth in the future. (Matthew 24:29-30) (Matthew 24:42,44) And, like the other predictions of Jesus, it will come true.

When I returned from my time away, Dudley and Tucker were overjoyed. Their waiting (for their Master to return) was over. Likewise, when our Lord returns, we will be overjoyed. He told us that He would be back, and we know he loves us.

Clergy Reference Report:

Pastor Burt discussed the need for updates to this report. The charge for using the sanctuary for weddings was discussed. Marshall made a motion that this charge be updated to \$100 for non-member use of the sanctuary. Rob seconded the motion, and it was approved.

This motion was seconded by Rob, and all approved.

The next meeting will be held on June 7, 2017, at 6:00 p.m.

Gary made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Marshall seconded the motion, and all approved.
