

PROPHESY #24: Ten Nation Confederacy and Rise of the Anti-Christ

In the history of the world, three great empires have come and gone. They are: the Babylonian, the Medo-Persian, and the Greek empires. (Daniel 7:2-7) The forth empire, the Roman empire, was never defeated by a greater nation, but instead, faded away. In Biblical prophesy, we

read that the Roman empire will rise again.

Ten Nation Confederacy

In the Old Testament book of Daniel, God reveals a vision of the future, to the prophet Daniel. The vision includes beasts and "horns" which are difficult to understand. In Daniel 7:23, God explains that the forth beast represents the Roman empire. Daniel would not live to see it, but it existed during the life of Jesus. In Daniel 7:24, the prophesy begins.

The ten "horns" represent ten Roman kings. (One from each of ten countries formerly in the original Roman empire.) These form a political union which is called the Ten Nation Confederacy. It elects a leader, and it governs in the revised Roman empire.

Rise of the Anti-Christ

Later, "another, different king" will arise. (Daniel 7:24) He will subdue three of the ten Roman kings, thus gaining more power. He will eventually take over the remaining seven kingdoms, and become the World Leader. Then the World Leader will become the World Dictator. He will make all the rules. He will speak against God (blasphemy) (Daniel 7:25), and he will put his image in the Jewish sanctuary to be worshipped. (defiling the temple.)

The World Dictator is the Anti-Christ. He is "against Christ" and desires to replace Christ. He elevates himself and demands to be worshipped instead of God. He is Satan's chosen replacement for God. He will hunt and kill the Jews and the Christians during the Great Tribulation. Other names for the Ant-Christ are: "man of sin" and the "lawless one".

God's prophesy of the rise of the Babylonian Empire, the Medo-Persian Empire, the Greek Empire, and the Roman Empire came true. His prophesy of the Ten Nation Confederacy and the Anti-Christ will come true also.

The October 1 **Crop Walk** had over 30 walkers who earned \$4318, which is sent to Church World Services. 25% of that amount is returned to the local community for our Food Pantry.

Meals on Wheels is averaging just under 20 meals each day. Friday is the day that CUMC delivers. Thank you Marshall Allen, Mary Hupp, Fred and Peggy Pearce, Sharry Semans and Dale and Cindy Dutton. We could use a substitute couple or individual from January – March when several drivers are gone. Tell Cindy if you can do this. Any of us will take you along on Friday to familiarize you with the route. It is a very rewarding hour of your time.

The **Cuba Food Pantry**, housed at the Baptist Church but the responsibility of all, had 4 requests for food assistance (food plus a certificate for fresh dairy and meat from Giant), and 3 requests for gas assistance in September; October requests were 5 for food and 2 for gas. Currently the Pantry is well stocked but most of that will be distributed on December 14. Our own Mary Hupp has agreed to sort and stock the donations during the winter months. Thank you Mary!

The Food Pantry especially welcomes boxed potatoes, boxed stuffing mix, and canned cranberries for the December distribution. Our UMW collects your donations in the Green Street Foyer on the first Sunday of every month and takes them to the Pantry.

Coming up...The Fat Tuesday Dessert Buffet will be held at our church on February 13, 6:30. Everyone attending brings a dessert but we need: A Chairman, beverages and musical entertainment. Please see me if you can work on this fun community event.


